Authority for collection of personal information	The Australian Public Service Commissioner (the Commissioner) has a number of functions relating to the Australian Public Service (APS). Your information is being collected for the purpose of the Commissioner's functions under paragraph 41 of the <i>Public Service Act 1999</i> (the Act).
Why does the Commission collect your personal information?	The Commission collects your personal information for the purpose of undertaking an evaluation of the Strategy. The information you provide will help the Commission understand how APS agencies use the Strategy and its impact.
What would happen if the Commission did not collect your personal information?	If the Commission did not collect your personal information, you would be unable to participate in formal stakeholder feedback on the Strategy via a survey and/or stakeholder interview.
Who will the Commission disclose your personal information to?	The Commission will not disclose your personal information to any parties. Your de-identified views may be included in public reports or presentations relating to the Strategy and its evaluation.

Access to and correction of your personal information.	The Commission's Privacy Policy contains information about how you may access and seek correction of personal information about you that is held by the Commission.
Privacy complaints	The Commission's Privacy Policy contains information about how you may complain about a breach of the Australian Privacy Principles and how the Commission will deal with complaints.
Overseas disclosure of your personal information	Personal information is not disclosed to overseas parties.
